NOTICE

Requirements of Grand Blanc Township Ordinance 86-009 “Excavation, Removal and Filling of Land”

1. All work shall be executed and inspected in accordance with all local and state rules and regulations and all established codes.
2. All existing storm sewers, sanitary sewers and natural watercourses crossing property shall not be obstructed due to the filling, excavation or through change in present elevations.
3. Owner and/or Applicant shall be responsible for and shall protect adjoining property, public thoroughfares, public utilities, etc., from damage due to this operation.
4. Keep drives and streets free from waste materials resulting from this operation. Truck beds shall be tight and loads shall be trimmed to minimize spillage. Temporary drives with culverts may be required to minimize tracing. Clean streets as may be required.
5. Adequate measures shall be taken to control dust caused by the operation.
6. Only clean fill dirt shall be placed in the fill area (no wood, brush, asphalt, etc.). Upon completion, surface shall be topped and graded with two feet of soil suitable for growing of turf. All areas to be seeded, mulched and stabilized.
7. Applicant/owner shall at all times be aware of possible inconveniences caused to adjoining owners and the general public. If undue inconveniences are not remedied, the Charter Township of Grand Blanc, upon twenty-four (24) hours notice, reserves the right to correct any inconveniences and bill the permit holder(s) for all costs incurred.
